

An Saorbhriathar

Irish has a verb form known in English as the 'autonomous form' or in Irish, *an saorbhriathar*, the 'free form'. This form corresponds roughly to the English passive voice and to impersonal verb forms such as found in 'one says ...', 'they sell...' 'you take the #5 to get downtown'. This booklet presents the basic morphology of the **saorbhriathar** and exercises to practice the forms.

There is a form for the saorbhriathar corresponding to each of the main tenses, present, past, imperfect, future and conditional.

1. The **present** tense form uses the endings **-tar - tear** according to the broad or slender stem of the verb.

Dúntar na siopaí ar a cúig a chloig gach lá.

The stores close at five o'clock every day.

Óltar cupán tae le brioscáí.

One drinks a cup of tea with some biscuits.

Múintear Gaeilge san ollscoil.

Irish is taught at the university.

Ceannaítear bainne sa siopa grósaera.

People can buy milk at the grocery store.

2. The **past** tense form of the saorbhriathar is formed by adding **-(e)adh** to first conjugation verbs, and **-odh** to second conjugation verbs. The initial

consonant of the verb is not lenited.

Dúnadh na siopaí ar a cúig a chloig.

The stores closed at five o'clock.

Óladh cupán tae le brioscáí.

One drank a cup of tea with biscuits.

Múineadh Gaeilge san ollscoil.

Irish was taught at the university.

Ceannaíodh bainne sa siopa grósaera.

People bought milk at the grocery store.

3. The **Imperfect** (aimsir ghnáthchaite) past tense forms the saorbhriathar by adding the ending **-t(a)i** to the root of the verb. The initial consonant of the verb itself is lenited as for the past tense. **D'** precedes verbs beginning with a vowel as for the past tense.

Dhúntaí na siopaí ar a cúig a chloig.

The shops used to close at 5 o'clock.

D'óltaí cupán tae le brioscáí.

One used to drink a cup of tea with biscuits

Mhúintí Gaeilge san ollscoil.

Irish used to be taught at the university.

Ceannaítí bainne sa siopa grósaera.

People used to buy milk at the grocery store.

4. The **Future** tense forms the saorbhriathar by adding the ending **-f(e)ar** to the root of the verb for first conjugation verbs, and **-ófar -eofar** for second

conjugation verbs:

Dúnfar na siopaí ar a cúig a chloig amárach.

The stores will close at five o'clock tomorrow.

Ólfar cupán tae le brioscáí.

One will drink a cup of tea with some biscuits.

Múinfeart Gaeilge san ollscoil.

Irish will be taught at the university.

Ceannófar bainne sa siopa grónaera.

People will buy milk at the grocery store.

5. The **Conditional** tense forms the saorbhriathar by adding the endings **-f(a)í** to the stem of first conjugation verbs and **-ófai** **-eofái** to the stem of second conjugation verbs. The initial consonant of the verb is lenited as for past tense forms. **D'** precedes verbs beginning with a vowel as for the past tense.

Dhúnfaí na siopaí ar a cúig a chloig.

The stores would close at five o'clock.

D'ólfaí cupan tae le brioscáí.

One would drink a cup of tea with some biscuits.

Mhúinfí Gaeilge san ollscoil.

Irish would be taught at the university.

Cheannófaí bainne sa siopa grónaera.

People could buy milk at the grocery store.
